30 Communities hosted Steps for Life walks across Canada



5,500+ people walked, including 246 community teams across Canada



Over \$690,000 was raised, including \$270,000+ in sponsorship

- 232 new family members found Threads of Life in 2016;
- 181 family members attended a family forum;
- 2,600 receive a copy of Threads newsletter each quarter;
- 7,755 people heard our speakers' messages last year.
